

RESOLUTION 2017-9-1

NORTHWEST LAKEWOOD SANITATION DISTRICT

JEFFERSON COUNTY, COLORADO

**A RESOLUTION OF SUPPORT FOR THE DISTRICT'S NOVEMBER 7, 2017
BALLOT QUESTION.**

WHEREAS, the Northwest Lakewood Sanitation District ("District") is a quasi-municipal corporation and political subdivision of the State of Colorado that provides sanitary sewer service to the properties and residents located within its boundaries; and

WHEREAS, the District has undertaken a multi-year renovation project to renew and replace its aging collection system; and

WHEREAS, the District continues to experience increased costs for the management and operation of its collection system and increased costs for the treatment of its wastewater by the Metro Wastewater Reclamation District; and

WHEREAS, without increasing taxes, the District has placed before its voters a ballot question seeking authority to collect, retain, and spend, all District revenues received by the District; and

WHEREAS, in the absence of such Authority, the District, in many years is required to refund a portion of its revenues through a temporary mill levy reduction; and


WHEREAS, the District's ability to continue its multi-year renovation project as well as its ability to meet its continuing financial obligations, including payment of increasing wastewater treatment costs will be enhanced if the District, **without increasing taxes**, is entitled to retain all revenues that the District receives on an annual basis; and

WHEREAS, the Colorado Fair Campaign Practices Act prohibits the spending of District funds to support such a ballot proposal, but the Act does authorize the adoption and distribution in normal fashion of a Resolution regarding the issue.


NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Board of Directors of the Northwest Lakewood Sanitation District that the Board does hereby express its strongest possible support for the ballot question as placed before the voters for a November 7, 2017 decision, and further confirms that this is a vitally important measure necessary to the investment in and maintenance of the District's wastewater collection system and is necessary to promote and foster the health, safety, and welfare of current and future District residents.

ADOPTED on the 27th day of September, 2017 by the Board of Directors of the Northwest Lakewood Sanitation District, by a vote of 4 for and a vote of 0 against.
